

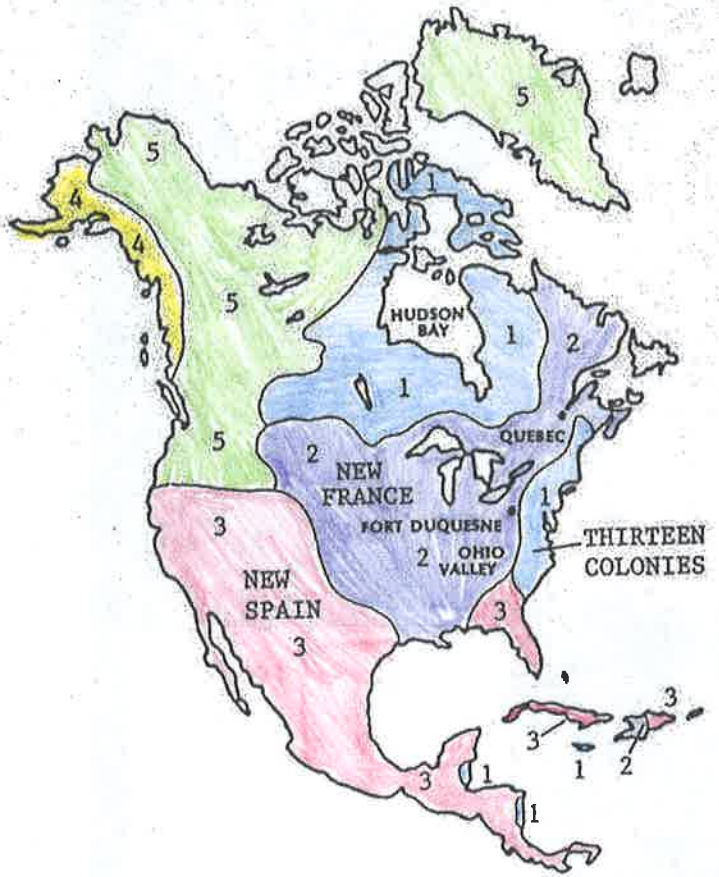
## FRENCH AND INDIAN WAR MAP
