5. New World: Term specific for the Americas.
6. Plantation: Large farms that used a slave force to harvest cash crops.
7. Western Hemisphere: A portion of the world that contains the Americas.
8. Slavery: The practice of using conquered people to do work.
9. Eastern Hemisphere: A portion of the world that contains Asia, Europe, and Africa.
10. Export: A crop or product that is sent out of the country.
